
Set in the historic heart of Nantes, the Château des ducs de Bretagne is the city's most important historic building, along with the Cathedral St. Pierre.

It was built in the late 15th century by François II – the last Duke of Brittany – and later by his daughter, Anne of Brittany, who was twice Queen of France. This castle is filled with six centuries of history, and a palatial residence with sophisticated façades and Renaissance-era loggias. Recent archaeological, historical, and architectural discoveries allow for the history of this monument to be approached differently. In the heart of Nantes' medieval district, the courtyard, ramparts, and moat are accessible. A must-see tourist attraction, with views over the city that can be freely explored, it is also home to the resolutely contemporary Nantes History Museum, and hosts major international exhibitions every year, providing a window on other civilisations.

VOYAGE THROUGH NANTES' VINEYARDS



Taking Le Voyage à Nantes' route through the region's vineyards is like taking a brief day trip to Italy by just stepping outside the city gates. The breathtaking beauty of Château de Goulaine, a note of Tuscany in Clisson, the Italian-style estate of La Garenne Lemot... Expect the unexpected and swirl it all together in a glass of one of Nantes' very own wines. Recognized everywhere by great chefs, it is now near-impossible to mention Muscadet wine without thinking of Nantes and its gastronomic traditions. New this year is Le Porte-Vue: an architecturally audacious lookout point in Château Thébaud by Emmanuel Ritz that overlooks the Maine River valley and offers a panoramic view of the vineyards.

VISIT OF CLISSON

Nicknamed "Clisson l'Italienne", the city displays an architecture influenced by the Tuscan model. The castle marks the southern entrance to the Duchy of Brittany. When you reach the 15th century covered market and then cross the Sèvre river by the "Pont de la Vallée", you will discover the transalpine atmosphere of the city: tile and brick villas, gardens shaded by umbrella pines, rustic houses and antique statues.

Visit of a winery with Muscadet tasting

The most beautiful cellars of the Nantes vineyard open their doors to you to discover the history of the domain, the work of wine making in the cellar and the variety of the production during a tasting session.

We propose visits to discover the history of the Domaine, to understand the work of the vine, our soils, our techniques of wine making, to visit our cellar and our cellars. You will then test our dynamic range of communal appellations and organic Muscadets that make the reputation of the house.

tasting of 5 panache wines

The Domaine de la Chauvinière is located at the top of the slopes of the Maine River, which gives its name to the appellation "AOC Sèvre et Maine". The terroir is unique, it is a granite of Château-Thébaud, it represents only an island in the heart of the Muscadet vineyard of about 4 %.









LES MACHINES DE L'ILE

Les Machines de l'île is a completely new artistic project.

The brainchild of François Delaroziere and Pierre Orefice, it lies at the crossroads of the "invented worlds" of Jules Verne, the mechanical universe of Leonardo da Vinci and the industrial history of Nantes, on the exceptional site of the former shipyards. The Île de Nantes is home to a host of curious machines. These extraordinary machines come to life in the hands of the builders from

La Machine, and are brought to life between those of the Machines de l'île, before the eyes of the public. As they move back and forth between the construction workshop and the Gallery, they create a sense of movement in the heart of the former Dubigeon Nave. They give the island a mysterious reality, just as they did in the days when ships were launched there for all the voyages of the world.

New for 2022: 35 butterflies, inspired by the monarchs of Mexico, come to life at the end of their stems when a volunteer among the visitors straddles the pedals and flexes their calves. The coloured resin wings begin to flap, faster and faster, while the mechanisms of the stainless steel frame are set in motion by the clanking of six chains. The butterflies fly over an aquatic tank filled with reeds and duckweed. 24 fish already live there, a real little ecosystem.
